### **Job Summary:**

Adjunct Faculty members teach college courses for graduate and undergraduate students. The adjunct faculty are required, among other things, to teach a minimum of one or two courses per semester as assigned, undergo classroom observations, advise students, attend department and college faculty meetings, carry out committee assignments, support student activities, and may attend College ceremonies and other activities held at the College. The Appointee must also maintain appropriate course and student records and keep office hours as determined by Barber-Scotia College.

### **Job Duties:**

- Teaches/conducts college courses for graduate and undergraduate students: Teaches one or more subjects, as assigned.
- Prepares and delivers exciting lectures to students; stimulates class discussions using textbooks and other teaching materials.
- Adjunct instructors deliver courses and monitor student progress; communicate with students, department, and college personnel; and ensure all relevant learning resources are available to students.
- Candidates may be asked to teach daytime, evening, weekend and/or distance courses, depending on the school's specific needs.
