HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

Primary Role

The Head Men's Basketball Coach is responsible for the overall development and maintenance of the Barber-Scotia College Men's Basketball program. This includes the structural and administrative organization of the program.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop, recommend, and implement specific training/conditioning programs and skill development programs.
- Plan, organize, implement, and follow up on an extensive ongoing recruiting effort through written, verbal, and personal contact with student-athletes and their families.
- Prepare student-athletes for competition through thorough analysis and breakdown of scheduled conference and non-conference opponents.
- Recommend and enforce discipline of student-athletes for infractions of rules, regulations, and misconduct.
- Cultivate alumni and other constituencies to further the goals of the basketball program, department of athletics, and Barber-Scotia College.
- Effectively manage the financial resources and human resources allotted to the program.
- Ensure proper safety precautions are always followed.
- Ensure adherence to the rules, regulations, and policies of Barber-Scotia College.

Supervision Required/Given

Reports to the Director of Athletics and directly supervise assistant coaches, student support personnel, and student-athletes.

- Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree preferred.
- Good interpersonal and organizational skills.
- Knowledge of NCAA rules and regulations.
